Key Assumptions

- 1. Early Childhood OC shares a *common vision* with many other agencies throughout the county, but our focus is the EC Policy Framework.
- 2. Early Childhood OC works together with key *strategic partners* to further the impact of the EC Policy Framework.
- 3. Early Childhood OC provides support to enable agencies across sectors to increase their alignment with the EC Policy Framework.
- 4. Early Childhood OC is in all spaces on the *policy continuum*: education, awareness, implementation support, and driving policy, system and environmental change/improvement for young children and their families.
- 5. Early Childhood OC will *secure funding* as an organization and work with partners to increase their *priorities for funding* to include early childhood.

Goals and Objectives

- 1. Increase education and awareness of the EC Policy Framework.
 - a. Create clear messaging of Early Childhood OC
 - b. Build and maintain website
 - c. Increase media and public relations outreach
 - d. Use existing county platforms to share Early Childhood OC messages
- 2. Engage and maintain strategic partners
 - a. Add Advisory Groups to the current organizational structure
 - b. Recruit Early Childhood champions and initiate philanthropic council

3. Support EC Policy Framework Implementation

- a. Identify early adopters across sectors to develop models for implementing the EC Policy Framework specific to each sector
- b. Create tool kits/resources across sectors to support implementation of the EC Policy Framework
- c. Coach and facilitate the use of the EC Policy Framework across sectors
- d. Track implementation of EC Policy Framework countywide
- e. Recognize partners who have made changes using the EC Policy Framework

4. Drive Early Childhood Policy Change

- a. Connect with organizations to identify opportunities to inform policy agenda
- b. Create process and criteria to identify and support policy priorities
- c. Create a Policy Agenda
- 5. Change the funding landscape to include an early childhood focus
 - a. Increase the total number of funders who prioritize early childhood
 - b. By cultivating a change in the funding landscape, sustain Early Childhood OC and its strategic directions
